To add Shapefiles to your Consultation follow the guidelines below. These instructions can be forwarded to your GIS Technician for their reference.

Shapefile Upload

Spatial Information can be contained within a file called a shapefile. This file can be uploaded into the CIS to specify spatial location. Shapefiles should be contained within a zip file.

The shapefile must adhere to the following format:

- One shapefile only. May contain points, lines, or polygons (whatever best describes the spatial location
 of the activity). Do not put multiple shapefiles into one zip file.
- Projection: EPSG 4326 http://spatialreference.org/ref/epsg/4326/
- . No Z Data. Remove all z data if it exists.
- No multipart shapefiles. Please break any multipart shapes into individual shapes. A shapefile may contain multiple single-part shapes.
- · File names should:
 - · Contain no spaces or symbols. (Underscores are allowed)
 - · Must be shorter than 32 characters
- · Shapefiles should be zipped
 - . Be sure to include the .shp, .shx, and .dbf all together
 - . Do not put files in subdirectories. All files should be in the root of the zip file.
 - . The free Windows tool "7Zip" (http://www.7-zip.org/) is a handy utility.
